- We agree we should do at least one 50/50 raffle (for game on September 29). Need parent commitment to sell the tickets, need pre-approval from athletic department. Currently we are looking to do homecoming game.
- Krispy Kreme fundraiser during Garage Sale Weekend/Whitley Days; Natasha can research the details; our cost for regular glazed \$8.50/doz; filled donuts \$10/doz; suggested retail is double that cost
- Trailer we're putting off shelving in the new traileruntil end of season; but we definitely need to protect the floor; 5gal bucket of WhiteSeal (waterproof marine sealant/protection) \$75; Chad motions that we authorize buying the sealant; motion was unanimously approved; we will apply to new and old trailer as soon as feasible

- Senior gifts: put together something with mylar/foil we have? Let's trade ideas via email so we're prepared for that night
