#### **Smartmusic**

You will not be given these extra credit assignments until you complete the required assignments, so you cannot use them to improve your grade if you do not complete the required assignments. You do not have to do these extra credit assignments, they are optional.

#### Responding To Feedback

One of the most important aspects of Smartmusic is the ability for me as your teacher to give you feedback based on your performance. Unfortunately I found last semester that very few of you took the time to look at that feedback. This means that the suggestions that I gave you to improve were ignored, however unintentionally.
