*7:30 Parade concludes


Notes for students

- Dress: You need to wear your red Whitko band shirt, long dark blue jeans, black socks, and your black marching shoes
- Please be sure to eat something and drink plenty of water between rehearsal and the parade.
- **Very important** Students are responsible for their own transportation to and from the parade. Mini buses will not be available for transportation from Whitko High School.
- For students who are driving themselves, it is suggested that you park somewhere off of SR 13 halfway between Pierceton Elementary and Brower Park (the end of the route). Once the parade is over you'll walk back to your car.
- Students will need to take your parade instrument home with you after rehearsal.
 Percussion for the safety and security of the instrument, please transport them in the case with the harness separate.

Notes for parents/spectators

- The parade organizers have requested that parents do not drop off students in the main parking lot off of SR 13 at Pierceton Elementary. Parents will need to turn west on Pine Street just north of Pierceton Elementary, then south on Third Street into a separate parking lot. Look for signs and/or volunteers to direct you to the appropriate place. Please see the map on the next page for directions.
- Pickup will be at Brower Park, 105 East Market Street, which is the end of the route. You
 may either park there, or you may park anywhere in a residential neighborhood along
 the parade route.
- Please be sure to pick up your student by 7:30 PM.
