#### Arrival

- 1. Please plan to arrive at least one hour prior to your scheduled performance time.
- 2. There is no need to find Mr. VanPatten at Carroll. I will try to be at as many performances as I am able but as you can see there are some that overlap and I may not be able to do that.
- 3. When you arrive please go to your performance room. There will be a volunteer at the door. Let them know who you are and that you have arrived.

#### **Before Your Performance**

- 1. Go to your warmup room and get a good warmup in. These rooms are large and will have many other people warming up at the same time, so don't worry about that.
- 2. Leave your case in the warmup room but don't leave anything valuable in or around it.
- 3. If you are ready before your scheduled performance time, and the volunteer at the door is ready for you, you can ask to go early. Otherwise they will ask you to come into your performance room and wait for your scheduled performance time. If you are an audience member for another performance, please be polite and respectful as you are representing Whitko!

#### **During Your Performance**

- 1. Hand your judges' copy to the volunteer or the judge (some places do it differently).
- 2. When it's time for your performance be sure to introduce yourself: "Hi, my name is \_\_\_\_\_ and I'm from Whitko High/Middle School. Today I will be performing \_\_\_(title of your piece) \_\_\_\_ by \_\_\_ (name of composer) \_\_\_ " Adjust this accordingly for ensembles.

#### **After Your Performance**

- 1. After your performance is done take all of your things out of the performance room. Go back to the warmup room and put your instrument away.
- 2. Go back to the performance room and wait for your result. The volunteer will mark your result down on the schedule outside of the room and then give your music back to you.
- 3. Be sure to get your "Medal Claim Card". This is a card that says what medal you received. Take it to the commons and hand it in to get your medal. If you are in an ensemble be sure to go together.
- 4. You are free to go after you have picked up your medal.

#### Important Items to Remember for the Day

- 1. Remember to conduct yourselves professionally at all times. You are representing Whitko!
- 2. Dress nicely for this performance. One of the indicators on your scoresheet is "Appearance Relating To Performance".
- 3. Be early for each step of your performance. It's better to be early than late!!
- 4. If you have any questions you can ask the door volunteers or any other Carroll volunteer and they will be glad to help you.
- 5. You are more than welcome to attend any performance of any Whitko student, this is why you have our full schedule for the day. Just remember to be good, respectful audience members for any performance you attend.

Re: Details concerning upcoming Winds/Percussion/Strings Solo and Ensemble Performances

Dear Solo and Ensemble Parent:

We are pleased that you and your child will be with us on January 27, 2018 and want you to know that we will be doing everything possible to make your performance experience as positive as possible.

As a means of better communication, we are providing this "Parent Information Letter" to inform you of some important details to assist you in the quality of your experience on the performance day.

Our school is located at 3701 Carroll Road, Fort Wayne, IN 46818

If coming from the south: Take Lima Road (Hwy 3) north off I-69 for 4 miles. Turn left (west) on Carroll Road. The school is one mile away and on the left. You will want to turn onto Bethel Road in order to park.

If coming from the north: Take Lima Road (Hwy 3) south from Huntertown for 4 miles. Turn right (west) on Carroll Road. The school is one mile away and on the left. You will want to turn onto Bethel Road in order to park.

We are on Eastern Daylights Savings Time.

You will find that the best location to park will be the south event lot of Carroll High School. This entrance is just off Bethel Road. You will want to enter at the intersection of Kaylin Dr. and Bethel Rd. There will be a stoplight at this intersection.

Percussion equipment must enter at the loading dock near Door 10. Equipment trailers should enter at the loading dock entrance located off Bethel Road. This entrance is the first available entrance just south of the intersection of Carroll and Bethel Roads. All vehicles must be moved to the main south lot after unloading and must return to reload.

We would like to remind you of these very important points:

- 1. It is important to plan to arrive at least 30 minutes prior to your child's scheduled performance time.
- 2. Solo and Ensemble performance schedules are affected by many variables that might mean that your child will not perform at the exact time as scheduled. Please be patient.
- 3. It is very important that you do not interrupt a performance once it has begun. There will be "Door Keepers" that will assist the performance room in avoiding interruptions. Please be respectful of these volunteer workers.
- 4. Your child should provide music to the adjudicator that has all of the performance measures numbered. If your child is performing in an ensemble/group, a group leader should be responsible for this activity.
- 5. Please remember to turn off all cell phones and pagers prior to entering the performance area.
- 6. It is important that the warm-up rooms and hall areas be kept as quiet and accessible as possible. Please assist us in keeping the "noise" level to a minimum, especially outside of performance rooms.
- 7. There will be food available for you and your child at the performance site. Please be sure to keep all food and drink in the designated area and out of the warm-up and performance rooms.

8. After your child has performed, they should retrieve the music that was used by the adjudicator and a voucher card indicating the rating received, from the Doorkeeper of the performance room. The voucher card should be presented to a "Medal Table" at the performance site the day of performance to receive the appropriate award for performance.

9. The Adjudicator Sheet will only be made available to your Music Director or designated replacement at

the end of the performance day.

10. If your child receives a Gold Rating on a Group I level event and desires to perform at the State Level, they must inform and pay their director prior to leaving the performance facility. The School's Music Teacher or the Officially Designated Replacement must make all State Solo and Ensemble Entries on the District Performance Day.

If you should have any further questions, please contact your child's school music teacher for clarification.
